Water Plan Requirements:

- Label water main size and material on roadways.
- 2) Label domestic and irrigation meters. Show size of the meter, and label RPZ backflow preventer.
- 3) Show domestic meter size & number.
- 4) Show irrigation meter size & number.
- 5) Show by-pass meter size & number.
- 6) Show fire line meter size & number.
- 7) Label double detector check and size.
- 8) Label all tap valve locations and sizes.
- 9) Show service line to building and label pipe diameter and material.
- 10) Label steel casing diameter and length for jack and bore.
- 11) Engineer's or Land Surveyors seal and signature is required on plans.

Sewer Plan Requirements:

- 12) A legal sanitary sewer easement is required for all sewer lines outside of county right-of-way. Provide exhibit drawings, "Upon recording of this as-built, all sanitary sewer easements are dedicated to Forsyth County Water & Sewer Department (or private sanitary sewer owners) and cannot be removed without prior approval from Forsyth County Water and Sewer Department. Contact Hillery Maradiaga for sanitary sewer easement requirements. 678-455-9909 ext 2866."
- 13) Dimension and label all sanitary sewer easements.
- 14) Show where the storm pipe and water pipe crosses on the sanitary sewer profiles sheets.
- 15) Label all 6" clean-outs.
- 16) Provide sewer as-built profiles indicating the following elevations: top of manhole, invert in, invert out. Pipe diameter, material, slopes, size, and length must also be appropriately labeled.

- 17) Label sanitary sewer deflection angles at manholes.
- 18) Tabulate the linear feet of sanitary sewer pipe by diameter and pipe material.
- 19) Add the following notes:
 - No structures, fences, or other obstruction may be built on any sanitary sewer easement without prior approval from Forsyth County Water and Sewer Department.
 - No dumpster pads, roof or pool drains, or air conditioning condensate drains are allowed into sanitary sewer system.
 - The developer/contractor is responsible for maintenance of all infrastructures for a period of 18 months after the recording date of the final plat.

General Requirements:

- Backflow device must be tested by a certified backflow technician.
- For meters 3" or larger, the bypass around the meter will need to be chained off and locked. The chain will to be provided by the owner/developer and the lock will be supplied by FCDW&S at the owner/developers cost.
- There is a charge for each bacteria and chlorine test taken on site. This fee will be collected at the time the plan is presented for approval. (\$40.00 per sample)
- If water service is provided by a master meter, it is the developer/ owners responsibility to provide sub-meters as per Forsyth County Specifications and it is to be noted on the as-built.
