Public Notice of Election Day Polling Place Change

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections proposes to change the Election Day polling place for one precinct as listed below. A hearing to approve a final order adopting this change is scheduled to take place on Monday, April 14, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. at the Forsyth County Voter Registrations & Elections Office, 1201 Sawnee Drive, Cumming, GA 30040.

Notice of Change of Election Day Polling Place for 21-South Forsyth Precinct:

The Forsyth County Board of Voter Registrations and Elections does hereby provide notice, as required in O.C.G.A. § 21-2-265 (a), that the polling place for the 21-South Forsyth precinct may be changed to the Sharon Forks Public Library located at 2820 Old Atlanta Road, Cumming, GA 30041 for all elections in 2025 due to the scheduled construction at Sharon Springs Park. If approved, voters assigned to the 21-South Forsyth precinct will no longer vote at Sharon Springs Park Community Building on Election Day for county, state, federal or municipal elections in 2025.
