Safety Guidelines/Assumption of Risk

Forsyth County Water and Wastewater Treatment Plants are industrial work sites that operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You will encounter routine work activities and plant operations during your scheduled tour. To ensure a safe and informative visit to our facilities, we ask that you adhere to the following safety guidelines. ALL adult participants and guardians of children must sign this form prior to taking the tour. Please read and initial each guideline in the space provided, and sign the Assumption of Risk section. A completed and signed copy of this form must be brought to the tour on the scheduled day by each participant.

Safety Guidelines

 You must wear closed-toe shoes. No sandals, flip-flops, open toed, or high-heeled shoes are allowed. The tour will include walking and stair climbing
 Dress appropriately, as most of the tour is conducted outside
 Stay with the tour group at all times. Any person deviating from the guided tour, not following instructions, or acting in an unsafe manner may be removed from the tour
 Be aware of potential slip hazards or liquids on the floors
 Watch your footing as you step up or down
 DO NOT touch any equipment, buttons, switches or other items in the plant
 Follow the instructions of Forsyth County or other facilities staff at all times
 Except for emergencies, DO NOT use or have cell phones out during the tour. Please turn off cell phones or place in silent mode
 No cameras or picture taking allowed
 No running or shouting
 Backpacks, large purses, bags, etc. will not be allowed on the tour for safety reasons
 Do not lean over railings or tanks
Tours will be rescheduled if inclement weather occurs on your scheduled date/time
