#### **Hot Topic**

New guidance clarifies eligibility of faithbased organizations participating in the Paycheck Protection Program and Economic Injury Disaster Loan program.

The Small Business Administration issued guidance clarifying that all faith-based organizations impacted by Coronavirus are eligible to participate in the Paycheck Protection Program and the Economic Injury Disaster Loan program, without restrictions based on their religious identity or activities, to the extent they meet the eligibility criteria outlined in the CARES Act that was passed by Congress, signed into law by President Trump.
