> One of the items on this year's ballot that you have

likely heard a great deal about is the continuation of SPLOST (Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax). SPLOST is a special, one percent voter-approved sales and use tax in Forsyth County for a specified period of time (up to six years), raising revenue for designated programs or named capital projects. Past SPLOST programs have **Community Input Needed!** provided funding for a number of infrastructure projects.




## Paint&Electronics **RECYCLING EVE**
