

# State Route 9 Planning Study

## FACT SHEET

### What?

Forsyth County, in partnership with the Atlanta Regional Commission, is conducting a regional transportation planning study of the State Route (SR) 9 corridor from SR 306 to SR 369.

### Why?

Currently, about 10,000 vehicles a day use this section of SR 9. Projections suggest that this area will continue to develop and grow, resulting in over 25,000 vehicles a day in the future.

In addition, the 2018 Forsyth Comprehensive Transportation Plan identified the need to widen this section of SR 9 from 2 to 4 lanes.

### Your input

This Planning Study is being conducted to proactively identify the patterns and impacts of future growth to this section of SR 9. Community meetings will help us understand the community's vision for the corridor, confirm the need for widening (that was anticipated in the Transportation Plan) and create a timeline for implementing both short and long-term improvements to this section of SR 9.
